## UPDATES TO FIRST CHURCH PANDEMIC PROTOCOL

Our staff and lay leadership have been working hard to make decisions that are wise, grounded in science, and contextual when considering what protocols are needed as we continue to move forward. Given the high percentage of vaccinated individuals at First Church, the CDC's new guidelines, and the federal and state governments regularly increasing vaccine eligibility, we want to outline the ways we will be lessening restrictions while striving to maintain our safety and health.

- · We will continue to wear masks for worship and follow social distancing.
- While still practicing social distancing and wearing of masks, we will begin inviting
  the congregation to join together in spoken word and singing.
- Beginning June 6, we will no longer require worshippers to make a reservation before attending worship. We will be looking at creative ways to take attendance when you arrive but you will no longer need to make a reservation.
- Beginning June 6, we will offer a nursery (infants through Kindergarten) during worship. See Nursery Care update for further information.
- We are looking to resume in-person Sunday school beginning August 15. We recognize that in-person Sunday School works best when we can safely offer classes for children, youth, and adults. It is our hope that by mid-August many children and youth will have had the opportunity to be vaccinated as eligibility continues to increase which will make these opportunities much safer. At this time, we are working to renovate our youth space and finish our technology upgrade to make it possible for classes to offer both in-person and virtual options if they desire.

## NURSERY CARE

Nursery care during our 11:00am worship services will begin on Sunday, June 6 for infants through Kindergarten. We ask that you make a reservation **HERE** for your child so that we can adequately prepare our workers and rooms. (Though we will not turn children away who have not made a reservation.) Our nursery workers will be fully vaccinated and are excited to spend time once again showering our children with loving attention.
