The book of Daniel is best known for its stories around fiery furnaces and lions' dens. While we love to retell these stories, careful consideration of Daniel's context, genre, visions, and stories reveals a book that is teaching an exiled Jewish community how to faithfully live under foreign empires. Even in exile, God's faithfulness wins out. As one of the most apocalyptic books in the Old Testament, Daniel is rich with imagery and numerology that has led to many fanciful and erroneous interpretations. Join us in this series as we explore both the well-known parts of Daniel as well as some of

the stories you might not have heard before. In addition, we will consider the extended writings of the book that appear only in Greek and Latin versions of the text by taking a look at The Prayer of Azariah, Susanna and the Elders, and Bel and the Dragon. The book of Daniel offers hope even in the midst of difficult times and is still speaking to us today.

## COVID 19 PROTOCOL UPDATES

After consultation with our staff, musicians, lay leadership, and congregants, we recognize that the vast majority of the First Church community is fully vaccinated. Likewise, in our Birmingham community there has now been time for persons 12 years and older who wish to be fully vaccinated to do so. Therefore, we are happy to announce beginning Sunday, July 11, we will follow recommendations from the CDC that state persons who have been fully vaccinated and are beyond two weeks from their last vaccination may remove their masks while indoors. Those who have not been fully vaccinated are asked to remain masked for your safety. In addition, we know there are persons who are not able to be vaccinated at this time, such as children under 12 and persons who have had medical professionals advise against vaccination, as well as people who live with vulnerable persons who prefer to remain masked. We ask that if you fall into one of these categories you please continue to wear your mask for your health and the health of those you love. We will continue to provide masks if someone needs one. There will also no longer be reservations needed for worship nor nursery care. Our nursery will continue to offer care from fully vaccinated workers. Per recommendation from the CDC all nursery workers will continue to wear masks while offering care and all children over the age of 6 are asked to wear a mask for their health.



This year we will be offering a combined 4th of July worship experience that will be virtual. We recognize that many will be traveling this holiday after more than a year of vacations being postponed. Therefore, we are choosing to offer our community a virtual experience that can be accessed no matter where you located or what time is most convenient for you. The service will be streamed at 9:00am on Sunday, July 4 on Facebook and YouTube.

There will be no in-person worship this Sunday.
