# Community: COMMUNITY:

After more than a year apart, we are excited to re-launch our community groups this fall! These groups provide a sense of fellowship with one another and encourage deeper connection within our community. These groups meet every month or every several weeks depending on the group's preference. If you're interested in participating in a community group this fall, please read the descriptions of Dinner Groups and Life Groups listed below and email Katherine@firstchurchbhm.com.

#### What is a Life Group?

A small group of 4-6 people who have a high commitment level to meet regularly and maintain confidentiality as they build an intimate spiritual community. A Life Group provides safe space for each member to be heard, encouraged, and offered accountability in their individual faith journey. Each group will decide together how often, where, and for how long they will meet. Groups can meet in one another's homes, at the church, or at a restaurant. These groups do not require study preparation, however, they do require high confidentiality and a high level of commitment.

#### What is a Dinner Group?

A small group of people (approximately 12) who commit to at least one year of meeting together monthly for sharing a meal with the intention of fostering greater community and building relationships. The meal can be at a restaurant or at a group member's home. Dinner Groups are centered on fostering fun and strengthening friendships. These groups do not require study preparation.

We are thrilled you are considering participating in a Community Group at First Church. We will probably be packing on another weekday each month to be able to have around 400 bags ready each month. AT FIRST CHURCH


