The word Tenebrae is Latin for "darkness" or "shadows" and describes a service that offers prolonged meditation on the suffering of Christ. Through music, dramatic readings, and the play between light and dark we will remember what it must have felt like in those moments when Christ's death darkened the world. We invite you to join us as we remember the grief and loss of Good Friday.


