- The earliest air conditioning involved sliding 100 lb blocks of ice down a ramp into the basement.


### And never did I ever remember that.....

1. There was a rooftop playground on the 'new' education building with swings, a slide, monkey bars and a merry-go-round.






And Sunday school competition became increasingly ferocious. By 1941 it was take no prisoners for the Maybelle Taylor Class...


