As people of faith it is important that we pause in this "cancel" culture craze to discern how we might lead the way in society instead of following its trends. How can people of faith have humility, see disagreements not as personal attacks, offer just accountability when harm is done, and still allow for the possibility of redemption for all of humanity?
