In his book Falling Upward, Richard Rohr explores our human journey from the firsthalf of our life to the second-half. This weekend we will explore the ways life invites us to release our need for rules, being "good enough," and climbing the ladder. We will look at the archetypal "Hero/Heroine's Journey" to see that inevitable losses in life have the ability to lead us to a more liberating second-half where we release our grip on control and lean into acceptance.
