
SUNDAY, MAY 5 IN THE SANCTUARY

JULY 15 - 18 | 9:00AM - 1:00PM


During Arts Camp students will explore how they can be HEROES in their everyday lives. We will learn through crafts, science, song, dance, recreation, and more.
